



ROSALIE

(UEB 3459/1) was produced by crossing Aneta with Maypole Community Plant Variety Rights EU 35515 from 03. 06. 2013

Origin: Institute of Experimental Botany Prague (Strizovice), CZ

Tree: Diploid, medium vigorous, compact columnar type with greyed-purple young

leaves

Blossom: Mid-season, blooms heavily with red-purple flowers

Picking time: towards mid-October, fruits do not fall prematurely, hang well on tree until

November

Productivity: Precocious, produces regular heavy crops of small ornamental fruits

Fruit: Yields attractive ornamental fruits, form broadly globose-conical, transverse

diameter about 50 mm, skin russet free, ground yellow-green color is almost entirely covered with dark-red, stem short to medium long, flesh reddish, not

suitable for fresh eating

Diseases: Resistant to scab (*Vf*), tolerant to mildew

Comment: Ornamental variety of columnar type without specific requirements for growing

conditions. Exhibits an extremely columnar growth habit requiring only an occasional removal of competitive shoots. The variety is suitable for ornamental purpose mainly for home gardens as solitaire or for planting of hedge with recommended distance 50 cm between trees and may be suitable for making

jelly.
